

Summary Grade Sheet English 100

“A”	“A” work excels the expectations for the assignment. It goes above and beyond in clarity, content, organization, and presentation. 10-9 pts
“B”	“B” work is above average. It goes beyond meeting the assignment, but doesn’t go as far as “A” level work. “B” work may excel in some areas, but not in the majority of areas designated by the assignment. 8-7 pts
“C”	C” work meets the expectations of the assignment. It shows competency, but does not go above and beyond the assignment in any significant way. 6-5 pts
“D”	Below passing means that the work failed to meet the assignment’s requirements. 2-0 pts

Accurate

- /10 The author, title, and thesis are restated accurately and in first sentence of summary.
- /20 The summary accurately captures all primary supporting points and key sub-points in the essay.
- /10 The summary accurately restates the relationship between thesis, primary supporting points, and sub-points in the essay.

Comprehensive

- /20 Summary restates all primary supporting points and key sub-points. All major points in the essay are reflected in the summary.

Brief

- /10 Summary conveys all essential information concisely. It also omits extra examples or very minor points in the essay. It doesn’t exceed the length requirements on the assignment.

Neutral

- /5 Summary omits personal opinion, belief, or judgment.

Independent

- /5 Ideas in summary are attributed to the author throughout.
- /10 Terms and ideas in the summary are defined clearly so they make sense to someone who has never read the essay.

Editing/Clarity

- /10 The summary is edited so it makes clear the meaning of the ideas in the essay.
