

# AVID Tutors Needed!!

AVID is an elective course designed to prepare high school students for four-year college eligibility. Tutors will work with AVID students to focus on the AVID curriculum for writing, inquiry, collaboration, and reading as well as student success strategies, organizational skills, goal setting, course accountability, and speaker/field trip opportunities.

Hours Per Week: 2 hours a day, twice a week (4 hours total)

\*More hours available if you choose to work at additional schools.

Pay: \$9.00 per hour

Responsibility: As an AVID Tutor, you will lead tutorial learning groups that convene twice a week to support success in rigorous academic coursework. The primary responsibility of a tutor is to guide student learning using AVID tutorial methodologies. Training will be provided.
