

What is a sentence?

A sentence is a group of words. It has a subject and a verb. It starts with a capital and ends with punctuation.

- Examples:
1. The students love grammar.
 2. June is a beautiful month.
 3. The children eat oatmeal for breakfast.

Look at the following groups of words. Are they sentences? Write Y or N. If the answer is “N” make the sentence correct.

Example: a blue shoe N

Correction: He wears a blue shoe.
