ANOTHER vs. OTHER

ANOTHER = one additional. It is singular.

It can be

- an adjective -- *I want <u>another</u> dog.*
- an adjective used with "one"-- I have a dog, but I want another one.
- A pronoun that replaces a singular noun -- I have a dog, but I want to get <u>another</u>.

OTHER = additional. It is mostly used with plural nouns.

It is

an adjective, often used with "some." I want some other pets.

OTHERS = additional

It is

 a plural pronoun—Some dogs are well- behaved and others are not.
