Verb Tense Review: The PAST

• Describes an event in the past

RFMFMBFR

- Regular past tense verbs end in "ed."
- Irregular past tense verbs must be memorized.

Be careful that you do not overuse was/were in the past. You only need the "BE" verb if that is your main verb, or if you are using a past progressive tense, or a passive construction.

Examples:

I drove to school yesterday.

He talked to his sister this morning.

Her uncle lived in Mexico for three years.

They did not have any pets when they were young.

She won the race.

Describe what we did in class yesterday.
