Verb Tense Review: The PRESENT CONTINUOUS also called PRESENT PROGRESSIVE

- Describes an event that is happening right now
- Describes a temporary habit
- Describes a future planned or scheduled event

REMEMBER

This verb tense needs:

• [am, is, are] + ing form of main verb

Examples: The teacher is talking.

The sun is shining.

We are studying in level 5 this quarter.

She is living in Seattle.

They are arriving next week.

He is leaving on Saturday.
