Question

At the end of the chapter when Annamarie is warm in her bed, she thinks about protecting the Jewish people. Why is she worried? Why would she and the other Danish people have to protect the Jews?

Why is Ellen staying with Annamarie's family?

After the Nazis went to and left the Johansen house, Annamarie saw that the Star of David necklace that she had been clenching (holding strongly) in her hand formed an imprint of the Star of David into her palm. The author is using this image as a symbol about a deeper meaning of the story. What do you think is the author's meaning by having the Star of David imprinted in Annamarie's hand?

Chapter 11	Describe the ways different people were brave in this story.
Chapter 12	What do you think Annamarie was thinking when she saw her mother outside on the ground at the end of the chapter?
Chapter 13	After Annamarie meets and talks with her mother, they find a package on the ground. What does Annamarie have to do?
Chapter 14	What happens when Annamarie is on the dark path?
Chapter 15	What happened when the German soldiers found Annamarie?
Chapter 16 Due: Jan. 20	What did Annamarie learn from Uncle Henrik later that evening when they were talking in the Barn?
Chapter 17	What does Annamarie learn about her sister Lise's death?
