Grammar: The "BE" Verb

Statements:

SUBJECT	VERB	REST OF THE SENTENCE
I	am	a teacher.
He She	is	
It	is	a pencil.
We They You	are	students.

Contractions (positive):

I <u>am</u> = I'm	We <u>are</u> = We're
He <u>is</u> = He's	They <u>are</u> = They're
She <u>is</u> = She's	You <u>are</u> = You're
It <u>is</u> = It's	

Questions:

VERB	SUBJECT	REST OF THE SENTENCE	ANSWER
Am	I	a teacher?	Yes, you are. No, you are not.
	he she		Yes she is. No, she is not.
Is	it	a pencil?	Yes, it is. No, it is not.
Are	we they you	students?	Yes, you are. No, you are not. Yes, they are. No, they are not.

Negative Statements:

SUBJECT	VERB	NOT	REST OF THE SENTENCE
I	am (I'm)	not	a teacher.
He She	is not (isn't)		
It	is not (isn't)		a pencil.
We They You	are not (aren't)		students.

Contractions (negative):

I <u>am</u> not = I'm not***	We are <u>not</u> = We aren't
He is <u>not</u> = He isn't	They are <u>not</u> = They aren't
She is <u>not</u> = She isn't	You are <u>not</u> = You aren't
It is <u>not</u> = It isn't
