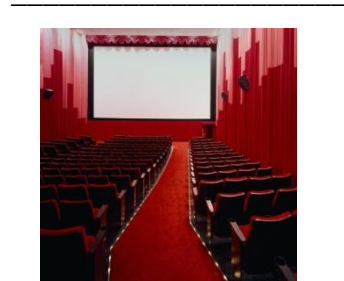
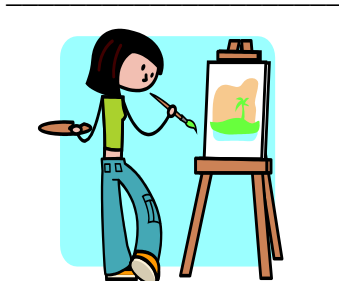



Grammar in context-L3 activity: Charades

Directions: Students take turns pulling a verb from a hat. S/he must act out the verb without talking. Other students can either take turns in groups writing their answer on a portable whiteboard in complete sentences or can take turns saying what the other student is doing while using present continuous (e.g., S/he is swimming). Another possibility is to have a group of students take turn saying what the other student is doing (e.g., You are swimming) and the other group must take turns writing the answer in 3rd person with a contraction (She's/He's swimming).

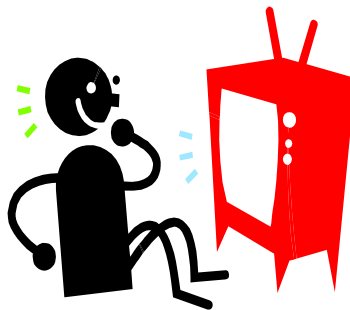
